



KINGSFIELD GOLF COURSE

COURSE ENTRY

1. All golfers **MUST** report to Reception before playing the course.
2. In the interests of safety and to avoid congestion, no golf bags are allowed in Reception. Please either leave them in your car until you are ready to start your game or leave them in the storage area outside the Reception building.
3. Each player **MUST DISPLAY** a valid ticket on their bag at all times on the course.
4. Founder Members of Kingsfield Golf Club & the green keeping staff are authorised to ensure that the course entry, dress code and course etiquette rules are enforced.
5. Any player without a valid ticket will be asked to leave the course immediately and may be banned for a period of time.
6. Each player **MUST** have his or her own golf bag and clubs.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

Golf courses require to operate to a quality standard and Kingsfield aims to earn a top quality reputation as a course worth visiting. All players are required to adhere to the following standards:

1. **RAKE ALL BUNKERS** after standing in them or playing from them. Leave rakes **INSIDE** the bunkers after use.
2. **REPAIR ALL PITCH MARKS ON THE GREENS.** It is a well known fact that full recovery is possible if pitch marks are repaired immediately.
3. **REMEMBER TO RING THE BELL ON LEAVING THE 1ST GREEN TO INFORM PLAYERS WAITING ON THE 1ST TEE THAT IT IS SAFE TO DRIVE.**
4. **NEVER ENTER A WATER HAZARD (POND OR DEEP BURN).**
5. **DO NOT ENTER FIELDS ADJOINING THE COURSE TO RETRIEVE BALLS.** These are private properties.
6. **KEEP UP WITH THE GAME IN FRONT, DON'T JUST KEEP AHEAD OF THE GAME BEHIND.**
7. **BE AWARE OF THE GAME BEHIND YOU.** If you are playing slowly, let a faster or smaller group play through. This will help to reduce frustrations on the course.

8. **IF YOU ARE SEARCHING FOR A 'LOST BALL', WAVE THE NEXT GAME THROUGH.** Potentially this allows you the full 5 minutes to find your ball as opposed to trying to keep ahead.
9. **REMEMBER TO SHOUT 'FORE' IF YOUR BALL IS HEADING TOWARDS ANOTHER GROUP OF PLAYERS.** This will help to keep players safe. If in doubt, always err on the side of shouting 'fore'.
10. **REMEMBER TO BE AWARE OF OTHERS ON THE COURSE AND AVOID SHOUTING & RAUCOUS BEHAVIOUR**
11. **MAKE SURE THAT YOU PUT YOUR RUBBISH IN THE BINS PROVIDED.**
12. **THERE ARE NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GOLF COURSE, SHORT GAME AREA, DRIVING RANGE OR OCHILS PUTTING GREEN.**
13. **PLEASE DO NOT USE A MOBILE PHONE ON THE COURSE UNLESS IN AN EMERGENCY I.E. INJURY OR ILLNESS.** Ring tones and people talking on the telephone are very annoying on the golf course.
14. **IF YOU ARE PLAYING 18 HOLES, THE RECEPTION STAFF WILL ALLOCATE A SECOND STARTING TIME 2 HOURS AFTER YOUR ORIGINAL STARTING TIME E.G. IF YOU START YOUR 1ST 9 HOLES AT 9AM, YOU WOULD BE EXPECTED TO START YOUR SECOND 9 HOLES AT 11AM.** However, if you complete your 1st 9 holes in much less than 2 hours or much more than 2 hours and the tee is free then proceed on to your 2nd 9 holes.

DRESS CODE

Although we are proud to welcome all golfers to Kingsfield, we believe that there are certain standards that players expect and we would respectfully ask that you follow the conditions below and dress in appropriate smart/casual clothing suitable for golf:

1. **PLEASE AVOID WEARING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS**

FOOTBALL TOPS

FOOTBALL SHORTS

T-SHIRTS

TRACK SUIT BOTTOMS

DENIM JEANS

RECEPTION STAFF ARE AUTHORISED TO DENY ACCESS TO THE COURSE TO PLAYERS WEARING ANY OF THE ABOVE ITEMS OR OTHER ITEMS OF CLOTHING/ FOOTWEAR THAT THEY CONSIDER TO BE INAPPROPRIATE.

2. **IDEALLY GOLF SHOES SHOULD BE WORN BY ALL PLAYERS BUT WE WILL ALLOW TRAINING SHOES (ESPECIALLY FOR YOUNGER PLAYERS)**
